PURPOSE

This policy does the following:

- a. Defines what a course is within the medical education program
- b. The various terms for the word course used within the medical education program

POLICY

The medical education program defines a course as any academic plan of study that is associated with an academic credit and appears on a student's final transcript.

Within the medical education program, a course may be referred to as one of the following:

- a. course
- b. block
- c. clerkship
- d. elective
- e. selective
