## **PURPOSE**

To ensure that medical students can obtain academic counseling from individuals who have no role in making assessment or promotion decisions about them.

## **GUIDELINE**

Academic success consultants and Associate and Assistant Deans for Student Affairs in the medical education program cannot participate in the summative assessment of medical students nor in advancement or promotion decisions regarding students enrolled in the medical education program.

## **SCOPE**

All students enrolled in the medical education program.

## **PROCEDURE**

- A. The guideline regarding the noninvolvement of academic success consultants in the assessment or promotion of medical students will be presented to the academic success consultants and Associate and Assistant Deans for Student Affairs upon their hiring.
- B. The guideline will be reviewed with the academic success consultants and Associate and Assistant Deans for Student Affairs on an annual basis.
