In most cases, Special Circumstances Requests/Reviews will not be processed until parents have completed their 2018 federal taxes and are able to obtain their 2018 federal tax return transcript or 2018 federal tax return and applicable schedules.

- * If you estimate that your 2019 and/or 2020 income will be less than your 2018 income reported on the FAFSA due to
 - loss of employment
 - separation/divorce or death of a parent
 - reduction in work hours/pay, (not including overtime or bonuses)
 - loss of income/benefits, etc.
 - inflated income due to withdrawal of funds to pay for education
