THE INTER RESIDENCE HALL GOVERNMENT (IRHG) ECO-REP PROGRAM:

The Eco-Reps will meet regularly with the Office of Sustainability Programs, get hands-on education concerning waste and change management, and get exclusive access to sustainability and social justice courses. The Eco-Reps will aid with residence hall trainings on waste diversion, lead the hall during the annual energy reduction competition, and promote sustainable practices within their own halls and within all IRHG activities. Each first-year residence hall will have a minimum of two Eco-Reps, these Eco-Reps will have the opportunity to become Sustainable Creighton Ambassadors for the IRHG in their second year, working on high-impact initiatives in collaboration with the Office of Sustainability Programs.
