Tasks before you arrive in Omaha

Creighton On-Campus Housing Information (Pharmacy Students):

Creighton University Housing is excited to offer on-campus housing options to those participating in the Distance Pathway! The website for summer housing is found at <https://www.creighton.edu/living/summer-housing>.

Applications for summer housing will be available after April 2. After that date, all current Creighton students will be able to apply via the [Housing Portal](#) and can direct any specific questions summerhousing@creighton.edu.

Please note that Creighton's undergraduate Commencement ceremony is Saturday, May 11, 2024, which will hinder Housing's ability to offer accommodations prior to that date. A limited number of housing options will be available beginning Sunday, May 12, and will be assigned based on room availability and application date.

Pharmacy students stay in Heider Hall, primarily in double occupancy, two-bedroom apartments. Two students are assigned to each apartment, and share a bathroom, kitchen, and living space.

A limited number of one-bedroom or efficiency apartments may be available to students who are seeking private accommodations. Guests will be permitted this summer as space allows, except for the first group in May. Pharmacy students may designate their own roommates or have Summer Housing assign a roommate.

If a student wants to bring a guest, they will indicate so on their application. Those desiring to bring more than one guest have the option of an entire Heider Suite for their privacy (when available). This housing option would only be offered to those bringing numerous guests, but we would not assign that space to an individual seeking private accommodations.

The rate for Summer 2024 varies based on room space:

- Kenefick/Heider Private One Bedroom: \$46.00/person/night
- Kenefick/Heider Private Efficiency \$43.00/person/night
- Heider Suite Double (Private Bedroom, Shared Bath): \$35.00/person/night

Additional charges due to room damage, services, or other requests made by program participants will be the individual participant's responsibility.

Check in begins at **3 PM**** on the date of arrival. Check out is at ****9 AM**** on the date of departure.**

Students will be allowed to check-in the day before lab begins and the day after the last scheduled day of lab requirements.

Students are billed according to the dates of stay requested in this application. Changes to dates of stay must be submitted to summerhousing@creighton.edu no less than 7 days prior to your arrival.

*Meal plans are not required for Pharmacy, though may be purchased if desired. More information on how to access a meal plan will be in the Housing Application.

If you would like to rent linens (flat sheet, fitted sheet, blanket, pillow, pillowcase, two towels and one washcloth) for the duration of your stay, they will be available at check in. An additional \$12 will be added to your student account for use of linens. To wash/dry laundry there is no charge.
